

Testing Announcements and Reminders for the North Carolina End-Of-Course and Final Exams

Exam Dates: January 14-January 21 (see separate Exam Schedule)

North Carolina End-of-Course tests and teacher made exams are required in order to survey student knowledge and mastery of subject related concepts. Students should attempt to do their best and attempt to do each question on the tests.

Students are asked to bring all needed materials such as number 2 pencils. Students should not bring dictionaries, reference books, textbooks, cell phones, mp3 players, cameras, iPods, thesauruses, smartpens, or extra blank paper. These are not allowed to be on or used during any part of the testing session. Being in possession of any of the listed items during the exam may result in a misadministration and result in the student or the entire class being required to take a retest.

We encourage students to get a good night's rest before each exam, eat a nutritious breakfast, and stay for review sessions in the afternoons and study for exams in the evening prior to taking the final exam.

As a reminder, EOC tests will be calculated as 25% of the entire grade for Algebra I & II, Biology, Civics and Economic, English I, Physical Science, and US History. All other exams will be calculated as 20% of the entire grade for the semester.

Please arrive on time to school during the exam week as exams begin promptly. If a student is late - for any reason – they will not be allowed to enter and take an exam once the testing session has begun. Students will then be required to attend make-up session to complete their exams.
