NOTES: EOC Retests

Only students who passed the course but did not receive a Level III or higher on the EOC will take the retest. Teachers will notify students on the evening that the exam was taken if they need to retest. The grade on the retest does not affect the student's final grade in the course. Rather, it allows the student another opportunity to meet the graduation requirement. For ALL EOCs, Retest 1 will be required for those students making Level II. Students who score a Level I students may opt to take the EOC Retest or go to a review committee to determine whether or not the student has demonstrated proficiency.

Algebra I, English I, Biology, Civics and Economics, and U.S. History are exit stand requirements – meaning students must pass them with a level III to graduate high school.

*** Focused Intervention**

If students do not make a Level III or higher on Retest #1, they will receive focused intervention from our staff on test taking strategies before retest #2.

*** EOC Retest #2**

All students who need retest #2 will receive focused intervention on test taking strategies and will retest after the intervention. Students will be notified of their scores as soon as we receive them.

- All exams (except EOC retests noted above), must be taken by Tuesday, February 1. Any student missing an exam must have the permission of their grade-level assistant principal to makeup the exam.
- On early release days (Jan. 15, 19, 20), buses will depart at 11:50 am. On January 21, buses will depart campus at 10:35 am. All students remaining on campus after that time must be taking an exam under the supervision of a teacher.
- Once students leave campus on an early release day, they may not return without a parent/guardian.
- Students should not be on other school campuses during exam days.
- We ask students who may want a snack to eat during the 15 minute break to please provide their own.
