*In the 2006 Teacher Working Conditions Survey, FVHS scored lower than WCPSS schools on all 5 domains. In the 2008 Teacher Working Conditions Survey, FVHS not only showed increases in all domains but FVHS also surpassed WCPSS schools in all but one domain (Facilities & Resources).

Leadership - explains the presence of leadership conditions that contribute to trusting, supportive, empowering environments, and sustained efforts to address teacher concerns.

Professional Development - explains the resources and opportunities available for teachers to participate in professional development.
